D. STAGE 1 WATER ALERT: (continued)

When the utility observes wasteful water use practices or when such wasteful uses of water are reported to the utility, the utility shall attempt an in-person contact with the customer or other person on the premises to request compliance with these restrictions, or if that is not possible, shall leave at the premises a door hanger notice making such request.

Subsequent continued wasteful water use practices may lead to the discontinuance of water service to the premises pursuant to Tariff Rule No. 11.

STAGE 2 WATER SHORTAGE: A Stage 2 condition exists when the Commission, the utility or authorized government agency determines that due to drought or other water supply conditions, a water supply shortage or threatened shortage exists and a further reduction is necessary to provide utility service to customers.

- Stage 2 of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan will be activated upon a determination that
 water usage should be further reduced and that the requirements in Stage 1 are not sufficient
 to comply with demand reductions ordered by the Commission or authorized government
 agency.
- 2. Additional Water Shortage Contingency Plan Measures: In addition to the non-essential or unauthorized uses of water identified in Stage 1, the following water use restriction requirements apply during Stage 2 of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan, except where necessary to address an immediate health or safety need or to comply with a term or condition in a permit issued by a state or federal agency:
 - a. Watering Days: The watering or irrigating of lawn, landscape or other vegetated area with potable water is limited to the following two (2) days per week unless the local governmental agency (i.e., city or county) designates different days:

Street addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8: Monday and Thursday All other street addresses: Tuesday and Friday

The other provisions of watering days, hours, and duration as detailed in Stage 1 continue unchanged.
