An original and four copies of this advice letter are submitted in compliance with Ordering Paragraph Nos. 1, 6 and 8, of D.17-06-008, dated June 15, 2017, in Application 16-01-002 to implement the adopted rates and other specified changes for Test Year 2017-2018. In accordance with D.17-06-008, this is a **Tier 1 advice letter**, with a requested effective date of July 1, 2017.

Purpose and Background

On June 15, 2017, the Commission adopted D.17-06-008 in Application No. 16-01-002. The relevant Ordering Paragraphs are as follows:

- The December 9, 2016 joint motion, set forth in Appendix C, for approval of the Settlement Agreement regarding the Test Year 2017/2018 General Rate Case of San Gabriel, including Escalation Years 2018/2019 and 2019/2020 is granted.
- 6. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to file by Tier 1 advice letter revised tariff schedules reflecting the adopted rates specified in Appendices A and B attached to this order, and to concurrently cancel its present schedules for such service. The revised tariff sheets shall (a) be effective five days after filing subject to approval by the Commission's Water Division; (b) comply with General Order 96-B, and (c) apply to service rendered on or after their effective date.
- 8. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to establish a Memorandum Account to record the revenue requirement related to the purchase of water rights.

The relevant sections of the adopted Settlement Agreement for this advice letter are as follows:

II.C.1 <u>Income Tax Repairs Regulations Memorandum Account</u> (p. 10) ... RESOLUTION: San Gabriel agrees to close the memorandum account without recovering the account balance and with no effect on its rates.

- II.C.2 Cost of Capital Litigation Memorandum Account (p. 10) ... RESOLUTION: ORA agrees to allow San Gabriel to amortize the full balance over 12 months.
- II.C.3 <u>Preliminary Statements</u> (p. 10) ... RESOLUTION: San Gabriel Agrees to revise its tariffs to add descriptions of its water and power balancing accounts, but such revisions should not be considered a condition precedent for permitting amortization of these accounts.
- III.E.16 Water Rights (p. 28) ... RESOLUTION: ... The parties agree that San Gabriel should be authorized to establish a Memorandum Account to record the revenue requirement related to the purchase of water rights, and so request that an ordering paragraph to this effect be included in the Commission's decision.
- III.1.1 Rate Design/Construction Service Tariffs (p. 36) ... ISSUE: San Gabriel seeks to modify construction service tariffs in both operating divisions to eliminate fixed charges and authorize a uniform quantity rate. ... RESOLUTION: ORA agrees with these modifications.
- III.1.2 Rate Design/California Alternative Rates for Water ("CARW") Program (p. 36) ... RESOLUTION: San Gabriel agrees to the ORA proposal for a uniform \$9 subsidy for all meter sizes.
- III.J.1 <u>Pumped Water and Purchased Water Balancing Accounts</u> (p. 37) ... RESOLUTION: The Parties agree to the consolidation of these accounts.
- III.J.3 Cost of Capital Interim Rates Memorandum Account (p. 37) ... RESOLUTION: The Parties agree to transfer the balance in the CCIRMA to the PABBA and close the CCIRMA.
- III.J.5 Resolution L-411A Memorandum Account (p. 38) ... RESOLUTION: The Parties agree that San Gabriel will close the L-411 memorandum account with no effect on rates.
- IV.I.2 Rate Design/Construction Service Tariffs (p. 61) ... ISSUE: San Gabriel seeks to modify construction service tariffs in both operating divisions to eliminate fixed charges and authorize a [sic] uniform quantity rates. ... RESOLUTION: ORA agrees with these modifications.
- IV.I.3 Rate Design/California Alternative Rates for Water ("CARW") Program (p. 61) ... RESOLUTION: San Gabriel agrees to the ORA proposal for a uniform \$9 subsidy for all meter sizes.

Discussion

For Los Angeles County division customers, the effect of these adopted rates increase the typical monthly bills of the average residential customer (5/8" x 3/4" meter and 14 Ccf) by \$8.30 or 13.7% from \$60.46 to \$68.76 as compared to rates effective September 20, 2016. Overall, test year revenue requirements will be increased by \$7,233,000 or 11.3%.

For Fontana Water Company division customers, the effect of these adopted rates increase the typical monthly bills of the average residential customer (5/8" x 3/4" meter and 19 Ccf) by \$18.71 or 27.7% from \$67.49 to \$86.21 as compared to rates effective September 20, 2016. Overall, test year revenue requirements will be increased by \$15.314.000 or 27.5%.

In addition to the above changes in base rates and CARW surcharges and surcredits, the following additional changes are made in accordance with D.17-06-008:

- 1. Resolution L-411A Memorandum Account: Section P1 of the Preliminary Statement is deleted.
- 2. Income Tax Repairs Regulations Memorandum Account: Section P2 of the Preliminary Statement is deleted.
- 3. Cost of Capital Litigation Memorandum Account: Section K of the Preliminary Statement is deleted. The April 2017 balances of \$58,174 for the Los Angeles County Division and \$59,563 for the Fontana Water Company Division are transferred to the Previously Authorized Balances Balancing Accounts ("PABBAs) and will be amortized through temporary, 12-month amortization rates of \$0.0048/Ccf and \$0.0041/Ccf, respectively. Note that the only additions to these accounts since the general rate case was filed are the accrual of interest on the monthly average balances.
- 4. Cost of Capital Interim Rates Memorandum Account: Section O2 of the Preliminary Statement is deleted. The April 2014 over-collected \$46,236.79 balance for the Los Angeles County Division and under-collected \$19,569.80 balance for the Fontana Water Company Division are transferred to the PABBAs. Note that the only additions to these accounts since the general rate case was filed are the accrual of interest on the monthly average balances.

- 5. Water and Power Balancing Accounts: New Sections P1 through P4 are added to the Preliminary Statement to describe the existing procedures used to compute these accounts.
- 6. Water Rights Memorandum Account: A new Section K is added to the Preliminary Statement to describe this newly authorized account.

No earnings tests are associated with this advice letter. Workpapers supporting the surcharges needed to amortize the Cost of Capital Interim Rates Memorandum Account have been provided to Water Division staff. Distribution of this Advice Letter is being made to the attached service lists in accordance with Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B and San Gabriel will post this Advice Letter on its websites in accordance with Water Industry Rule 3.3. No further public notice is required because all public notices in connection with Application No. 16-01-002 have already been made in accordance with applicable law and Commission rules.

- 2. The private fire service facilities shall be installed by the utility or under the utility's direction and shall be the sole property and subject to the control of the utility, with the right to alter, repair, replace and the right to remove upon discontinuance of service.
- 3. The minimum diameter for the private fire service connection will be 4 inches. The maximum diameter shall not be larger than the diameter of the water main to which the private fire service facilities are attached unless said main is circulating, in which case with the approval of the utility the maximum diameter may be larger by not more than 2 inches than the diameter of said circulating main.
- 4. If a water main of adequate size is not available adjacent to the premises to be served, then a new main from the nearest existing main of adequate size will be installed by the utility at the cost of the customer. Such cost shall not be subject to refund.
- 5. The private fire service facilities will include a detector check valve or other similar device acceptable to the utility which will indicate the use of water. The facilities may be located within the customer's premises or within public right of way adjacent thereto. Where located within the premises, the utility and its duly authorized agents shall have the right of ingress to and egress from the premises for all purposes related to said facilities. In the event the installation is solely a private fire hydrant facility, the requirement for a detector check valve or other similar device may be waived.
