This advice letter is submitted in compliance with General Order 96-B. This is designated as a Tier 1 advice letter, with a requested effective date of July 1, 2023.

Advice Letter 589 June 9, 2023

### **Purpose**

San Gabriel seeks by this advice letter authorization to designate its currently authorized rates as set forth in the tariff sheets listed above as interim rates effective July 1, 2023, and to make conforming modifications to its Preliminary Statement. Pursuant to Public Utilities Code §455.2, interim rates were authorized by Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Susan F. Lee's Ruling Granting Interim Rates in A.22-01-003, dated May 31, 2023. The foregoing interim rates will be subject to refund and adjusted upward or downward, consistent with the final rates adopted by the Commission in the pending general rate case. A new Interim Rates Memorandum Account ("A.22-01-003 IRMA") will be opened to track the difference between revenues billed under the interim rates and the revenues that would have been billed had the rates adopted by the Commission in A.22-01-003 become effective as scheduled on July 1, 2023.

#### Discussion

On January 3, 2022, San Gabriel filed General Rate Case Application No. 22-01-003 for its Los Angeles County and Fontana Water Company divisions. On April 14, 2023, San Gabriel filed a motion for interim rate relief in the event a decision could not be issued in time for rates to become effective on the first day of the test year, July 1, 2023. As of the date of this advice letter, a proposed decision has not yet been issued. The above-referenced May 2023 ALJ ruling grants San Gabriel's motion for interim rates with the following ordering paragraphs:

- 1. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to a Tier 1 Advice Letter to implement interim rates for its service territories in the Los Angeles County and Fontana Water Company divisions at the current rates. San Gabriel shall also establish an interim rates memorandum account to track the difference between the interim rates and the final rates adopted by the California Public Utilities Commission.
- 2. The interim rates shall become effective no sooner than July 1, 2023, and be subject to refunds and adjusted upward or downward, consistent with the final decision adopted by the California Public Utilities Commission.

The present rates in the Los Angeles County became effective on January 1, 2023 by Advice Letter 583. The present rates in the Fontana Water Company division became effective on January 1, 2023 by Advice Letter 584.

#### Request

San Gabriel requests that its currently authorized rates be designated as interim rates and to make conforming modifications to its Preliminary Statement in compliance with ALJ Lee's Ruling, dated May 31, 2023, in the pending rate case.

#### Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) San Gabriel did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which San Gabriel relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on a policy objection to an advice letter where the relief requested in the advice letter follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any further responses, protests or comments, except for San Gabriel's reply, after the 20-day comment period. San Gabriel will reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response in accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 7.4.3.

- 1. The customer will pay, without refund, the entire cost of the private fire service facilities.
- 2. The private fire service facilities shall be installed by the utility or under the utility's direction and shall be the sole property and subject to the control of the utility, with the right to alter, repair, replace and the right to remove upon discontinuance of service.
- 3. The minimum diameter for the private fire service connection will be 4 inches. The maximum diameter shall not be larger than the diameter of the water main to which the private fire service facilities are attached unless said main is circulating, in which case with the approval of the utility the maximum diameter may be larger by not more than 2 inches than the diameter of said circulating main.
- 4. If a water main of adequate size is not available adjacent to the premises to be served, then a new main from the nearest existing main of adequate size will be installed by the utility at the cost of the customer. Such cost shall not be subject to refund.
- 5. The private fire service facilities will include a detector check valve or other similar device acceptable to the utility which will indicate the use of water. The facilities may be located within the customer's premises or within public right of way adjacent thereto. Where located within the premises, the utility and its duly authorized agents shall have the right of ingress to and egress from the premises for all purposes related to said facilities. In the event the installation is solely a private fire hydrant facility, the requirement for a detector check valve or other similar device may be waived
