San Gabriel submits this advice letter in compliance with California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC" or "Commission") Decision ("D.") 24-03-005, dated March 7, 2024, in Application ("A.") 22-01-003 to implement revenue increases of \$3,297,400 or 3.4% in the Los Angeles County division and \$4,163,500 or 4.4% in the Fontana Water Company division for Escalation Year 2025-2026. In accordance with Ordering Paragraph No. 8 of D.24-03-005, **this is designated as a Tier 2 advice letter** with a requested effective date of July 1, 2025.

#### Purpose and Background

This advice letter requests authority to implement rates for Escalation Year 2025-2026 as authorized by the Commission for the Los Angeles County and Fontana Water Company divisions in D.24-03-005, dated March 7, 2024, in A.22-01-003. Ordering Paragraph No. 8 of D.24-03-005 states:

8. San Gabriel Valley Water Company shall file a Tier 2 escalation year Advice Letter for Escalation Year 2024-2025 and Escalation Year 2025-2026, in conformance with Decision 07-05-062, the Rate Case Plan for Class A Water Utilities, proposing a new revenue requirement and corresponding revised tariff schedule. San Gabriel Valley Water Company's filings must include rate procedures as set forth in the California Public Utilities Commission's Rate Case Plan for Class A Water Utilities and must include appropriate supporting workpapers. The revised tariff schedule must take effect no earlier than July 1, 2024 and July 1, 2025, respectively, and such Advice Letters shall follow the escalation procedures in the Rate Case Plan, and will apply to service rendered on and after their effective date. The Tier 2 Advice Letter shall also report over- and under-earnings during each escalation year.

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph No. 8 of D.24-03-005, the revised tariff schedules shall take effect on July 1, 2025.

The present rate schedules in the Los Angeles County and Fontana Water Company divisions became effective on January 1, 2025, through Advice Letter 614.

#### Discussion

Based upon the escalation rates for 2025 and 2026 published on April 30, 2025 by the Public Advocates Office, San Gabriel requests increases of \$3,297,400 or 3.4% in the Los Angeles County division, and \$4,163,500 or 4.4% in the Fontana Water Company division, for Escalation Year 2025-2026.

An earnings test is required to implement the Escalation Year 2025-2026 increases. The earnings test yielded pro forma rates of return for Escalation Year 2025-2026 of 7.78% for the Los Angeles County division and 7.68% for the Fontana Water Company division, which are less than the adjusted-adopted rates of return of 7.94% and 7.99% for the Los Angeles County and Fontana Water Company divisions, respectively. Therefore, no earnings adjustment is needed in deriving the proposed rates.

The tariff schedules reflecting the proposed changes are attached hereto. San Gabriel has provided workpapers supporting the calculation of the escalation year revenue requirements, earnings tests, and proposed rates to the Commission's Water Division staff for their review as required by D.24-03-005.

The proposed rates will increase the monthly bill of the typical customer in the Los Angeles County division with a ½" x ¾" meter and using 11 hundred cubic feet ("Ccf") on General Service Rate Schedule LA-1 by \$3.19 or 3.7%, from \$86.68 to \$89.87. The proposed rates will increase the monthly bill of the typical residential customer with a ½" x ¾" meter and using 11 Ccf on Conservation Rate Schedule LA-1C by \$3.06 or 3.7%, from \$83.42 to \$86.48.

The proposed rates will increase the monthly bill of the typical customer in the Fontana Water Company division with a \%" x \%" meter and using 14 Ccf on General Service Rate Schedule FO-1 by \$3.95 or 3.9%, from \$100.25 to \$104.20. The proposed rates will increase the monthly bill of the typical residential customer with a \%" x \%" meter and using 14 Ccf on Conservation Rate Schedule FO-1C by \$4.47 or 4.6%, from \$96.56 to \$101.03.

Finally, San Gabriel requests authority to cancel Preliminary Statement, Section S, the A-22-01-003 Interim Rates Memorandum Account, and remove Tariff Sheet No. 3284-W from the Company's tariff book, as this memorandum account was closed by Advice Letter 615.

#### Service and Notice

Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service lists in in accordance with Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B. No other parties have requested notification of tariff filings related to the Los Angeles County or Fontana Water Company divisions. In accordance with Water Industry Rule 3.3 of General Order 96-B, San Gabriel will also post this advice letter to its websites, <a href="https://www.sgvwater.com">www.sgvwater.com</a> and <a href="https://www.sgvwater.com">www.fontanawater.com</a>. San Gabriel will inform its customers of the overall net rate change effective July 1, 2025 in dollar and percentage terms by a billing message on the first bill on which the changes appear. No further public notice is required because all public notices in connection with A.22-01-003 have already been made in accordance with applicable law and Commission rules.

#### Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) San Gabriel did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which San Gabriel relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on a policy objection to an advice letter where the relief requested in the advice letter follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. #### **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. The customer will pay, without refund, the entire cost of the private fire service facilities.
- 2. The private fire service facilities shall be installed by the utility or under the utility's direction and shall be the sole property and subject to the control of the utility, with the right to alter, repair, replace and the right to remove upon discontinuance of service.
- 3. The minimum diameter for the private fire service connection will be 4 inches. The maximum diameter shall not be larger than the diameter of the water main to which the private fire service facilities are attached unless said main is circulating, in which case with the approval of the utility the maximum diameter may be larger by not more than 2 inches than the diameter of said circulating main.
- 4. If a water main of adequate size is not available adjacent to the premises to be served, then a new main from the nearest existing main of adequate size will be installed by the utility at the cost of the customer. Such cost shall not be subject to refund.
- 5. The private fire service facilities will include a detector check valve or other similar device acceptable to the utility which will indicate the use of water. The facilities may be located within the customer's premises or within public right of way adjacent thereto. Where located within the premises, the utility and its duly authorized agents shall have the right of ingress to and egress from the premises for all purposes related to said facilities. In the event the installation is solely a private fire hydrant facility, the requirement for a detector check valve or other similar device may be waived.

The facilities may be located within the customer's premises or within public right of way adjacent thereto. Where located within the premises, the utility and its duly authorized agents shall have the right of ingress to and egress from the premises for all purposes related to said facilities. In the event the installation is solely a private fire hydrant facility, the requirement for a detector check valve or other similar device may be waived.
