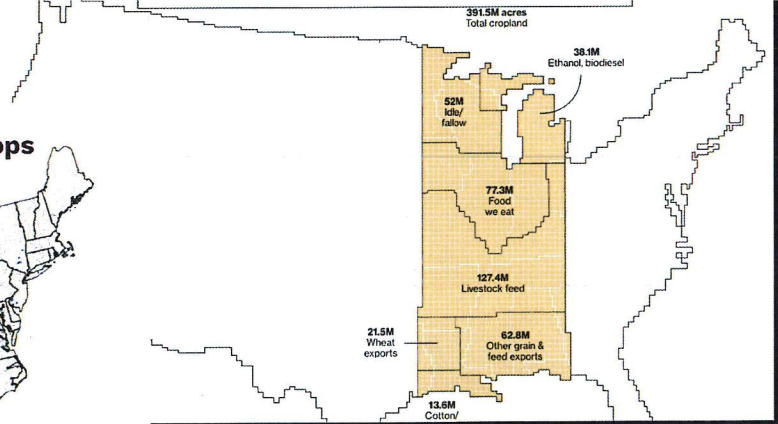


Agricultural land takes up about a fifth of the country.

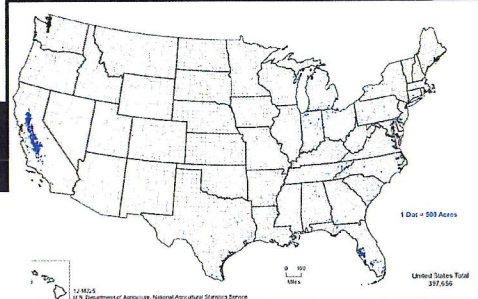


Tree Crops

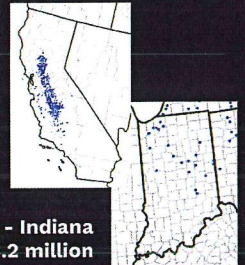


Tomatoes

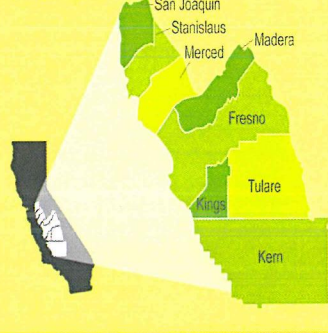


Lettuce



The San Joaquin Valley

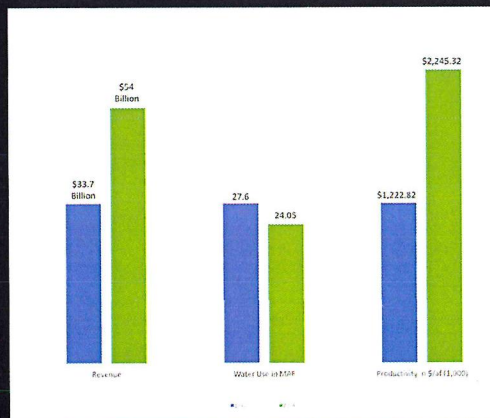
Comprised of eight counties with 62 cities.



- The size of West Virginia

- Only Mediterranean Climate in North America
- Home to 7 of the nation's top 10 agricultural producing counties
- CA produces over 400 commodities
- 1/3 of the nation's vegetables
- 2/3 of the nation's fruits and nuts
- 1 out of every 5 ga. of U.S milk production

WATER USE EFFICIENCY

- Farm production generated 60% more gross state product in 2014 than in 1980
- Farm water use declined almost 15%
- Productivity in \$ per acre-foot of applied water increased over 80%
