TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("San Gabriel") hereby requests review and approval of the following changes in tariff sheets applicable to its Los Angeles County ("LA County") division:

An original and four copies of this advice letter are submitted pursuant to Decision No. (D.) 10-04-031 in Application No. 08-09-008, and General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(1), to amortize the \$1,432,005 undercollection in the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism ("WRAM") Balancing Account as of October 31, 2014, through a temporary 12-month surcharge of \$3.13 per tiered-rate residential customer, per month. The surcharge will increase annual adopted revenues from \$65,916,558 to \$67,348,563 or 2.2%. D.10-04-031 established the WRAM and provides for amortization of the balance in that account. Ordering Paragraph 4(d) states:

(d) If the water revenue adjustment mechanism over- or under-collection for either ratemaking division exceeds 2% of that area's total authorized revenue requirement for the preceding calendar year, a tier 1 advice letter shall be filed within 30 days by San Gabriel Valley

Water Company that requests amortization of the balance in the account, which applies only to the residential class of customers. If the percentage is 2 or less, San Gabriel Water Company shall propose amortizing in the next General Rate Case.

This amended advice letter corrects references to the Commission's rules for noticing customers of the increase. In accordance with the above ordering paragraph and Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(1), **this filing is designated as Tier 1 and does not require a resolution.** The enclosed tariff schedules will become effective immediately.

Background

The current rate schedules in this division became effective on November 1, 2014 through Advice Letter No. 447.

D.10-04-031, dated April 8, 2010, in A.08-09-008 adopted conservation rates and authorized a Monterey style WRAM balancing account to record variances in Quantity Rate revenues from those that would have been billed under a single block Quantity Rate. The \$1,432,005 undercollection in that account exceeds 2% of the authorized \$64,739,867 revenue requirement for the preceding calendar year.

San Gabriel has furnished the Commission's Division of Water and Audits staff workpapers providing detailed support for the proposed surcharge. San Gabriel is proposing a per customer surcharge, applicable only to its residential customers, rather than a per Ccf surcharge because the use of outdated sales forecast would not provide for full amortization of the undercollected recorded balance. These workpapers show the computation of a surcharge of \$3.13 per residential customer, per month for twelve-months beginning on the effective date of this advice letter. The new rates submitted with this advice letter raise the monthly bill of the typical residential customer using 14 Ccf under Schedule LA-1C with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter by \$3.13 or 5.5% from \$57.40 to \$60.53.

The matters addressed in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Service and Notice

In accordance with Water Industry Rule 3.2 of General Order 96-B, San Gabriel will inform its customers by bill insert (a copy of which is attached hereto) in the first bill that includes the increase, of the amount of the increase, expressed in dollar and percentage terms. No other parties have requested notification of tariff filings.

Distribution of this Advice Letter is being made to the attached service lists in accordance with Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B. In accordance with Water Industry Rule 3.3 of General Order 96-B, San Gabriel will also post this advice letter on its website at www.sgvwater.com.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) San Gabriel did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which San Gabriel relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly

consider the protest.

2. Application and Eligibility Declaration: An application and eligibility declaration on a form authorized by the Commission is required for each request for service under this schedule. Renewal of a customer's eligibility declaration will be required every two years and may be required on an annual basis. Customers are only eligible to receive service under this rate schedule at one residential location at any one time, and the rate applies only to the customer's permanent primary residence. The schedule is not applicable where, in the opinion of the Utility, either the accomodation or the occupancy is transitory.
3. Commencement of Rate: Eligible customers shall be billed on this schedule commencing no later than one billing period after receipt and approval of the customer's application by the Utility.
4. Verification: Information provided by the applicant is subject to verification by the Utility. Refusal or failure of a customer to provide documentation of eligibility acceptable to the Utility, upon the request of the Utility, shall result in removal from this rate schedule.
5. Notice from Customer: It is the customer's responsibility to notify the Utility if there is a change in the customer's eligibility status.
6. Customers may be re-billed for periods of ineligibility under the applicable rate schedule.
7. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. AA-UF.
8. A surcredit of \$0.0406 per Ccf is to be applied to the quantity rates for a 12-month period beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 430-A to amortize the overcollection in the Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memorandum Account (CCIRMA).
9. A surcharge of \$0.1603 per Ccf is to be applied to the quantity rates for a 12-month period beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 432 to amortize the undercollection in the California Alternative Rates for Water (CARW) Memorandum Account.
10. A surcharge of \$3.13 per month for a 12-month period beginning on December 3, 2014 is to be applied to only tiered-rate customers to amortize the undercollection in the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (WRAM) Balancing Account. (N)

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**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY RATE INCREASE
BEFORE THE
CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION
Advice Letter 450-B**

San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("the Company") submitted Advice Letter 450-B to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on December 3, 2014 to implement a twelve-month surcharge to increase its revenues by \$1,432,005 or 2.2% to amortize the undercollection in the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism ("WRAM") Balancing Account as of October 31, 2014 in accordance with General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(1). The proposed temporary surcharge of \$3.13 per month will be charged for twelve-months to residential customers billed under tiered rates. The Company seeks the Commission's authority to implement this twelve-month surcharge and new rates became effective on submittal of the advice letter.

The impact of this proposed increase will raise the monthly water bill of the typical residential customer using 14 Ccf under Schedule LA-1C with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter by \$3.13 or 5.5% from \$57.40 to \$60.53. The company has submitted its supporting workpapers to the Commission staff for review and verification.
