3. A surcharge of \$0.1473 per Ccf is to be applied to the quantity rates for twenty-four months effective October 1, 2018 to amortize the net under-collection in the Los Angeles Drought Lost Revenue and Drought Surcharge Revenue Balancing Accounts.
