JOB SUMMARY

Under direction of a Facilities Maintenance Technician II or the Facilities Maintenance Supervisor, performs various maintenance duties associated with company buildings, grounds and operations facilities.

JOB DUTIES AND ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Responsible for a variety of tasks and duties which may include, but would not be limited to, the following:

- Prepare and paint buildings, reservoirs, fences, and pumping equipment and appurtenances.
- Repair and construct buildings, roofs, fences, walls, vaults, and masonry.
- Perform landscape maintenance, including leveling and spreading material, planting, pruning, irrigation installation and maintenance, mowing, and weed control.
- Spray herbicide at company facilities to control weeds.
- Pick up and deliver interoffice mail.
- Other tasks and duties as directed.

SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE AND PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Skills, knowledge and physical requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Knowledge of painting equipment including pneumatic and airless spraying equipment.
- Knowledge of general construction, applying roofing materials, and applicable tools.
- Ability to use a variety of hand and power tools associated with planting, pruning, landscaping, repairing fencing, herbicide spraying equipment, and lawn equipment.
- Ability to interact with supervisors and co-workers in a cooperative and professional manner.
- Communicate effectively verbally and write legibly.
- Knowledge of safety practices and procedures.
- Must be dependable, punctual, and have good attendance.
- Neat and presentable appearance.
- Ability to climb and work at heights in excess of 40 feet.
- Ability to lift 50 lbs. to waist level and maneuver equipment and implements weighing in excess of 100 lbs.
- Ability to perform repetitive physical activities, including sitting, standing, walking, reaching, grasping, pushing, pulling, lifting, bending, stooping, digging, climbing, crouching, squatting, crawling and twisting.
